Effect of default	 In case of non-fulfilment of RPO by obligated entities, the obligated entity may be asked by the Commission to deposit an amount into a separate fund created and maintained by the obligated entity. The amount of deposit shall be decided by the Commission on the basis of shortfall in RPO and the forbearand price. The fund shall be utilized to purchase certificates as may be decided by the Commission.
