

# Delhi Net Metering Regulations - 2014

## HIGHLIGHTS

<b>Control Period</b>	From the date of publication in the official gazette.
<b>Eligibility Condition</b>	A system with capacity of not less than 1 kWp and subject to the load sanctioned by the distribution licensee
<b>Capacity Target for Distribution Licensee</b>	Shall not be less than capacity limits specified by the Commission from time to time.
<b>Metering Arrangement</b>	Net meter shall be as per single phase or three-phase requirement.

## OTHER PROVISIONS

<b>Energy accounting and settlement</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Excess energy export over import shall be carried forward to the next billing period for adjustment against energy consumed in subsequent billing periods within the settlement period.</li><li>• At the end of the financial year, unadjusted net energy credits shall be paid for by the distribution licensee.</li></ul>
<b>Other charges</b>	Exempted from wheeling, banking, cross subsidy and other charges for a period of five years unless extended further.
<b>Penalty</b>	Not available
