Effect of default	 In case of non-fulfilment of RPO, the obligated entity may be asked by the Commission to deposit an amount into a separate fund created and maintained by the state agency. The amount of deposit shall be decided by the Commission on the basis of shortfall in RPO and forbearance price. Funds shall be used as may be determined by the Commission for purchase of renewable energy certificates.
