Effect of Default	 In case of non-fulfillment of RPO by obligated entities, the obligated entity may be asked by the commission to deposit into a separate fund created and maintained by the obligated entity. The amount of deposit shall be determined by the Commission on the basis of shortfall in RPO and forbearance price decided by the central commission. The fund shall be utilized as may be directed by the commission for purchase of certificates.
