

# Gujarat Policy for Development of Small Scale Distributed Solar Projects â€™ 2019

## HIGHLIGHTS

<b>Nodal Agency</b>	Gujarat Energy Development Agency (GEDA)
<b>Policy Period</b>	6 March 2019 to 6 March 2026.
<b>Eligibility</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Capacity between 500 kW and 4000 kW.</li><li>• Sale of power to DISCOMs only by individuals, company, body corporate, associations or farmers.</li><li>• The developer must own or lease land for the development of power plant.</li></ul>
<b>Tariff</b>	Tariff of power purchase by GUVNL added Rs.0.20 per unit. (Rs.0.12 for saving transmission loss + Rs.0.08 for compensation for land).
<b>Grid Support</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The developer will bring power to interconnection point and bear associated costs linked with it.</li><li>• Common transmission can be shared by a cluster of project developers.</li></ul>
<b>Deposit</b>	Rs.5 lakh per MW, refundable under Terms and Conditions.
<b>Forecasting &amp; Scheduling</b>	Exempted from intra-state transmission procedure until the forecasting and scheduling mechanism for solar parks is made applicable.
<b>Termination of PPA</b>	The developer will be fined six months billing amount, to be paid to the DISCOM.
<b>Metering</b>	ABT meter must be installed on the developer's side.
